

DUMMY DOWNHILL Saturday, March 2nd, 2019

All dummies must be registered by 3:00 PM on Saturday, March 2nd for the Dummy Downhill Race.

Registration is in the guest services office. Dummies will be inspected, weighed and measured before the event. The race will begin promptly at 4:00 PM.

- All Down Hill Dummies must be mounted to either one (1) snowboard or two (2) skis.
- For safety reasons, metal bracing or metal weights may not be used in dummy construction.
- Acceptable construction materials include: wood, plastic, wire, tape, foam rubber, vinyl, cardboard, or plastic tubing.
- Weight and ballast must consist of non-hazardous materials.
- Smoke effects are acceptable, but nothing incendiary that may cause the dummy to catch fire.
- Dummies must be at least 30 inches tall.
- Dummies may not exceed 40 pounds in weight.
- Dummies may not be living or breathing.
- After the race, it is the responsibility of the owner to remove and dispose of their dummy.

By signing below, you acknowledge that your dummy has been constructed of acceptable materials and does not contain any heavy metal or other hazardous parts. Any breach of these specifics will result in disqualification.
